John Gattorna



He has written several books along the way as his thinking has evolved, but his four most recent titles have been seminal: Living Supply Chains (2006), Dynamic Supply Chain Alignment (2009), Dynamic Supply Chains: Delivering value through people (2010) and Dynamic Supply Chains:
